1. A space initially allocated for a week may be extended to a second or subsequent week at the monthly rate and credit given for the first week paid.
2. A space initially allocated for a month may be extended to a second or subsequent month at the quarterly rate and credit given for the first month paid.

Warnings

1. Each berth holder will be issued with an LRSC **Boat Sticker** showing location of space allocated. This disk must be displayed in a prominent position on the transom or mast when the boat is parked in the compound. Failure to do so may result in the boat being treated as abandoned or illegally parked as described in the dinghy park regulations.
2. If you do not display a **Harbour Launching Sticker** the Harbour Master can claim a fee to launch (currently £13).

All boats and trolleys must be clearly and visibly marked. Any road trailers kept in the dinghy park must conform to Dinghy Park Regulations, paragraph 3d.

ALL BOATS AND GEAR ARE STORED AT THE OWNERS RISK AND THE CLUB ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGE OR LOSS HOWSOEVER CAUSED.

CARS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE DINGHY PARK

DUTIES LIST

All adult club members are expected to carry out an average of two duties a year – social members will be given social but not sailing duties.

OOD (Officer of the Day)

Has overall charge of the sailing activities requiring at least a basic understanding of race management. Responsibilities include deciding whether or not to race, setting and overseeing the laying of an appropriate course and directing the rescue cover.

AOD (Assistant Officer of the Day)

Assists with running the racing, willing to work under the instruction of the OOD and keen to develop their knowledge of race management. When 2 RIBs are in service the AOD may be required to act as additional RIB crew.

RD (RIB Driver)

A confident RIB operator, qualified to at least RYA level 2 with regular driving experience, having a basic knowledge of first aid and an ability to communicate effectively over the VHF radio. Knowledge of dinghy racing is highly desirable.

RC (RIB Crew)

Works under the instruction of the RIB Driver, having a basic knowledge of first aid, able to deploy and recover a series of heavy race marks and, although unlikely, willing to take to the water to provide assistance if necessary.

PJ Driver

A capable and confident operator of a small displacement craft, having knowledge of Club operating procedures for this boat.

Beach Officer

Provides shore based support to the OOD, confident in the use of a VHF radio, responsible for club security during racing and observing sailing activities in or close to the harbour. On Sunday, advise member doing tea duty if afternoon racing is cancelled.

Tea Duty

Tea Duty responsibilities include providing cakes and milk and serving teas following afternoon racing. Expenses are refundable.
