Health, Safety & Environmental Policy Statement

The Lyme Regis Sailing Club Ltd, hereafter known as “The Club” or “LRSC Ltd”, through its officers accepts the responsibilities of the organisation and will provide adequate resources to implement this policy.

The Club recognises the importance of integrating appropriate health and safety standards into all aspects of its activities. The Club believes that the only approach to injury, ill health and loss prevention is through the development of a positive safety culture, where everyone is actively involved in the systematic identification of hazards and the evaluation and control of risk.

The Club will fully uphold the commitments laid down in this statement by devising and implementing suitable health, safety and environmental practices. These practices will support the Club’s objectives to pursue, obtain and maintain the highest level of safety management performance. To achieve this goal, the Club will seek the cooperation of employees, club members and volunteers.

In the support of the above, the Club will provide and maintain a safe place of work, to include plant, equipment and systems of work that are safe and without risk to health.

Such provision in itself is unlikely to achieve the safety culture needed without the active involvement of the Club employees and Club members. To this end the organisation will provide suitable and sufficient information, instruction, training and supervision to all employees, members and volunteers. This will enable them to discharge their duty of care to themselves and others and to take a proactive approach in supporting this policy.

In order to maintain the highest possible performance standards in occupational health and safety, the Club will regularly review and monitor the effectiveness of its health and safety arrangements.
