Club Duty Bylaw

- Each adult in a Full or Family/Partnership membership will be expected to complete the duties allocated to them by the Committee in each year.
- Each member must complete the Duty Registration Form annually, either on the Club's website or on paper, by 31st December for the following year's duties.
- If a member fails to complete the Duty Registration Form on time, then he/she will be allocated duties by the committee at times to suit the racing programme.
- Duties are allocated for the period mid-March until the end of October.
- Members who wish to race in the Winter series will be expected to carry out additional duties.
- A non-sailing spouse in a Family/Partnership membership may apply for exemption from duties.
- Applications for exemptions of any sort will be considered by the member of the Committee responsible for managing duties in conjunction with the Officers of the Club.
- Members in poor health may apply for exemption from duties or can be allocated duties that are less physically demanding.
- Members aged 16 and 17 may volunteer to do duties suitable for their experience, but they must be under the supervision of an adult while carrying these out.
- The Committee will endeavour to allocate duties that are closely suited to the experience and fitness of members.
