Membership Categories:

a) Full Member

Being a person aged 18 years and over on January 1st of the subscription year and not in full time education.

b) Family/Partnership

Shall include one or two adults (aged 18 years and over on January 1st of the subscription year) and all children up to the age of 18 years of the age (on January 1st of the subscription year) living at the same address. Any children in full time education up to the age of 25 then they are also included. Both family/partners shall have the same rights and privileges as Full Members.

c) Youth/Student Member

Being a single person aged 10 to 18 years on January 1st of the subscription year. Anyone in full time education from the age of 18 -25 is also included. Note: members aged 10 to 18 years of age do not have voting rights.

d) Social Member

A non-sailing member who may use only the facilities available in the club house. A social member shall have only limited (as defined by the Committee) access to the Car park facilities and shall not be entitled to sailing facilities or voting rights.

Out of Port Member

Only available to ex Full or ex Family members; see Club Rule 9.1.f.

Temporary Member

Primarily intended for summer visitors from another club, may be granted in categories similar to a-d above.

- I. Such a member shall have full use of the Club facilities for a period not exceeding 14 days in any one year and subject to approval by two members of the committee, and includes temporary parking of one boat and provision of launching permit subject to payment of relevant fee, for that period.
- II. Shall not have the right to take any part in any management of the club (e.g. no admission to the General Meetings or entitlement to vote).
- III. Shall have no right to introduce guests or visitors to the Club or its facilities.

Please note that all Full members, Family members and Youth members 18 or over have to do duties.

DUTIES LIST

All adult club members are expected to carry out an average of at least two duties a year – social members will be given social but not sailing duties.

More explicit details regarding what each duty entails, including time and briefing notes that are shown on the club website & in the club programme.

RO (Race Officer)

Arrange for club to be unlocked.

Has overall charge of club racing requiring at least a basic understanding of race management and an ability to communicate effectively over the VHF radio.

Responsibilities include deciding whether or not to race, setting and overseeing the laying of an appropriate course, directing the rescue cover and ensuring race results are input into the appropriate program.

ARO (Assistant to Race Officer)

Assists with running the racing, willing to work under the instruction of the RO and keen to develop their knowledge of race management. When 2 RIBs are in service the ARO may be required to act as additional RIB crew.

RD (RIB Driver)

A confident RIB operator, qualified to at least RYA level 2 with regular driving experience and should also have the RYA Safety Boat Qualification or equivalent. Will need to have a basic knowledge of first aid and an ability to communicate effectively over the VHF radio. Knowledge of dinghy racing is highly desirable.

RC (RIB Crew)

Works under the instruction of the RIB Driver, having a basic knowledge of first aid, able to deploy and recover a series of heavy race marks and, although unlikely, willing to take to the water to provide assistance if necessary.

PJ Driver

A capable and confident operator of a small displacement craft, having knowledge of Club operating procedures for this boat. Also assists with running the racing.

Beach Master

Provides shore based support to the OOD, confident in the use of a VHF radio, responsible for club security during racing and observing sailing activities in or close to the harbour.

Please note that if you select RIB Driver or RIB Crew duties it will be assumed that you consider yourself to be sufficiently physically fit and able to enter the water in order to assist members and that you will be appropriately dressed in a wet suit or dry suit.

Please check your allocated duties when you receive the dutyman e-mail & make a note of the dates. If you are unable to do your duty, please make sure you arrange a swap with another member.
